The campus of GIIS spans 25,648 square meters, offering modern facilities to enrich student learning. The year 2026 has been remarkable for GIIS, with students excelling in various inter-school, district, state, and national-level competitions. School teams have participated in state tournaments, CBSE clusters, national championships, and National School Games, securing top positions in athletics, badminton, wushu, football, lawn tennis, and basketball. Among these achievements,

Under the RBSE tournaments 2025–26:

- Nishtha Choudhary represented the school in Lawn Tennis Under-14 at the state level.
- Mokshita Bhardwaj became the State Champion in Badminton, Under-17 and secured selection at the national level.
- Suman Choudhary achieved State Championship in Athletics, Under-17 and was selected for the national level.
